FIRST AID/CPR CERTIFICATION

Before you hit the road for those troop trips this spring, you must have your health and safety certifications up to date. A person certified in First Aid is required in order to take your troop on any outing away from your meeting place—and someone certified in CPR is required to utilize the council property at Camp Hazlewood.

Because Girl Scouts of Reelfoot Councils certifies participants through the American Red Cross, certification for First Aid must be renewed every 3 years while certification for CPR must be renewed every year.
